THE ISSUES

DONALD TRUMP

Defend and expand the Affordable Care Act, which covers 20 million people.¹

THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT (ACA)

Repeal and replace Obamacare with Health Savings Accounts (HSAs).²

Bring down out-of-pocket costs like copays and deductibles.¹

INDIVIDUAL HEALTH CARE COSTS

Continue to allow individuals to use HSAs. Contributions into HSAs should be tax-free and accumulate.³

Protect consumers from prescription drug price increases.¹

PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

Allowing consumers access to imported, safe and dependable drugs from overseas will bring more options to consumers.³

Encourage states to expand Medicaid and make enrollment through Medicaid and the ACA easier.¹

MEDICAID

Maximize flexibility for states via block grants so that local leaders can design innovative Medicaid programs.²

Expand access to affordable health care for families regardless of immigration status.¹

HEALTH CARE FOR IMMIGRANTS

Enforce the current immigration laws and restrict the granting of visas to relieve health care cost pressures on state and local governments.³

Expand access to rural Americans, who often have difficulty finding quality, affordable health care.¹


ACCESS TO CARE

"By following free market principles and working together to create sound public policy .. (we) will broaden healthcare access, make healthcare more affordable."²



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Ensure that all women have access to preventive care, affordable contraception, and safe and legal abortion.¹

REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

Defund Planned Parenthood if they continue to provide abortions and redirect the funding to community health centers.⁶

Enforce and broaden the ACA's Transparency Provisions.⁴

PRICE TRANSPARENCY

Require price transparency from all health care providers, especially doctors and health care organizations like clinics and hospitals.³

Increase premium tax credits available through the Marketplaces so that individuals and families pay no more than 8.5% of their income on health insurance premiums.⁵

HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS

Allow people to purchase insurance across state lines, in all 50 states, creating a dynamic market.²

Allow people age 55-64 to buy-in to Medicare.⁵

MEDICARE

Trump has not stated his position on Medicare program restructuring.

Integrate the mental and physical health care systems and enhance community-based treatment.⁷

MENTAL HEALTH

Reform mental health programs and institutions across the country.³
